General Information

Wedding Ceremonies

Exchange vows in a serene, picture-perfect setting overlooking our 27-hole championship golf course with swaying palms, glistening lakes and the majestic San Jacinto Mountains. Or, for a more formal setting, choose one of our indoor ballrooms.

The Resort requires the client to provide a professional coordinator for ceremonies on the property.

Receptions

You may reserve a maximum of any five (5) hour time frame for your reception:

Daytime Hours 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Evening Hours 5:00 p.m. – 12:00 a.m.

Additional hours will incur additional charges.

Function room assignments are based on the original number of anticipated guests as listed in your contract. The Hotel reserves the right to make reasonable changes in meeting or banquet facilities, including relocation of your group.

The Resort reserves the right to move any outdoor event inside due to inclement weather, or impending inclement weather, predicted by the National Weather Service. Parties will be moved due to wind, rain, or the forecast of rain. The decision to move such parties will be made five (5) hours in advance of such events with the engager's approval, if available. If the decision must be delayed or changed necessitating the Resort to set both the indoor and outdoor function space, an appropriate service charge will be made according to the party size and complexity of set-up.

Guest Accommodations

Special rates will be offered to your guests on availability when a minimum of ten (10) rooms are reserved on a single night.

Food and Beverage

No food or beverage of any kind may be brought into the banquet rooms by the client or any of the client's guests or attendees, with the exception of the wedding cake. In addition, no remaining food or beverage may be removed from the hotel premises.

Menu Selections

Menu selections should be submitted to the Catering department four (4) weeks prior to the event to ensure selection availability. All printed catering menu items and prices are subject to change without notice. Menu items will be guaranteed thirty (30) days in advance.

You may choose up to two (2) lunch or dinner entrees to offer your guests. In these instances, the exact number of each entrée

is to be specified with the guaranteed attendance. Place cards designating entrée selection are required to assure efficient service to your guests by our professional banquet team. A \$3.00 per person surcharge on the lesser-priced entrée will apply.

Event Guarantees

It is the responsibility of the client to provide a guaranteed number of guests ten (10) days prior to the event. This number may be increased by 12:00 noon, three (3) business days in advance of the event, but is not subject to reduction. Final charges will be based on the actual attendance or the final guarantee as submitted, whichever number is greater.

The resort cannot guarantee the same menu for increases to the guarantee once given.

Deposits

The Doral Desert Princess Resort will not confirm or hold space without a deposit. A deposit of 25% is required to guarantee the date. The 25% deposit is the total of the food and beverage minimum with taxable service charge, sales tax and ceremony fee if applicable. Another 25% deposit is required two months prior. The deposits are non-refundable/non-transferable. Cancellation fees may also apply.

Final Payment

The total estimated cost of the event is required ten (10) days prior to the event. Payment may be made with a credit card or cashier's check only. A credit card authorization form is required to guarantee any balance due upon conclusion of the event.

Decorations

Notification is required for any special decorations, set-up needs, and activities at the time of booking. No rice or birdseed is permitted indoors or outdoors. All centerpieces are to conform with local fire code requirements.

If a coordinator is not provided and the Resort is required to help with table favors, place cards, decorating, etc., a \$150.00 service charge will be added to the final bill.

Service Charge and Tax

All costs are subject to the applicable taxable service charge and sales tax. The obligatory service charge is not a gratuity and will be distributed at the discretion of management. Service charge is subject to CA State Board of Equalization Regulation No. 1603.

Damages

The client agrees to be responsible for any damage to the premises caused by his/her attendees and any vendors contracted by the client.

Bride's Calendar

6-12 MONTHS BEFORE

- ◆ Determine the type of wedding you want...size, setting, degree of formality.
- ◆ Discuss wedding budget with your parents, fiancée... and perhaps his parents.
- ◆ Plan a color scheme for wedding reception. Choose your dress and headpiece.
- ◆ Schedule fittings and delivery date.
- ◆ Determine the size of the guest list.
- ◆ Compile names and addresses of your guests.
- ◆ Select wedding attendants, both yours and his.
- ◆ Select and book photographer.
- ◆ Select florist and/or balloonist and discuss color scheme.
- ◆ Select and book entertainment.
- ◆ Select and book Videographer.
- ◆ Choose music and musicians/soloists/harpist for ceremony and reception.
- ◆ Consult a travel agent for honeymoon ideas.
- ◆ Complete honeymoon plans with groom.
- ◆ Announce your engagement in the newspaper.
- ◆ Select and register for china, silver, etc.
- ◆ Arrange appointment with personal trainer.

4-6 MONTHS BEFORE

- ◆ Shop together for wedding rings.
- ◆ Select and book transportation for wedding day.
- ◆ Select a baker and order wedding cake, groom's cake, and mints.
- ◆ Set date to order attendants' dresses and confirm delivery date for your dress.
- ◆ Begin shopping for men's wedding attire.
- ◆ Complete your guest list.
- ◆ Order invitations and announcements; start addressing them upon receipt.
- ◆ Shop for trousseau.
- ◆ Check blood test and marriage license requirement.

2-3 MONTHS BEFORE

- ◆ Select and book cosmetics/skin care specialist.
- ◆ Confirm all details with your hired professionals.
- ◆ Confirm ceremony details with your officiate. Select the men's wedding attire and order the right sizes.
- ◆ Arrange rehearsal details. Discuss rehearsal dinner with groom.

- ◆ Plan attendants' parties.
- ◆ Make appointment with your hairdresser.
- ◆ Arrange accommodations for out-of-town attendants and guests.
- ◆ Finalize honeymoon plans.
- ◆ Pick up wedding rings and check engraving.
- ◆ Mail your invitations.
- ◆ Write thank-you notes for gifts.
- ◆ See your insurance agent to review and combine your insurance needs.

1 MONTH BEFORE

- ◆ Have final dress and headpiece fitting.
- ◆ Have formal bridal portrait done.
- ◆ Purchase gifts for wedding participants.
- ◆ Complete shopping for your trousseau.
- ◆ Have attendants' parties.
- ◆ Ensure that your accessories are in order: toasting goblets, garter, candles, ring pillow, etc.
- ◆ Finalize rehearsal dinner details.
- ◆ Draw map to direct guests to the ceremony and reception.

1-2 WEEKS BEFORE

- ◆ Give a final guest count to the caterer.
- ◆ Give and/or attend bridesmaids' party.
- ◆ Confirm all honeymoon reservations and accommodations.
- ◆ Pick up tickets and travelers checks.
- ◆ Begin your honeymoon packing.
- ◆ Make sure you have your marriage license.
- ◆ Pick up wedding attire, make sure everything fits.
- ◆ Keep up with gift acknowledgments.
- ◆ Finish addressing your announcements to mail on your wedding day.
- ◆ Rehearse wedding ceremony with all participants.
- ◆ Remind maid of honor, bridesmaids of rehearsal dinner details; present gifts to attendants at rehearsal dinner.
- ◆ Get a good night's sleep the night before your wedding day.

ON THE WEDDING DAY

- ◆ Remain calm and try to relax!
- ◆ Don't forget to bring your wedding rings and your marriage license.

Groom's Calendar

The groom traditionally has fewer wedding responsibilities than the bride, but his involvement is vital. Couples living near large cities may need up to two years to plan.

12 MONTHS BEFORE

- ◆ Pick up engagement ring from jewelry store (if not yet selected).
- ◆ If you'll share wedding expenses, discuss with fiancée, and all parents.
- ◆ Discuss with fiancée how many ushers you'll need:
1 per 50 guests.
- ◆ Arrange appointment with your personal trainer.

9 MONTHS BEFORE

- ◆ Arrange a visit with clergy member, justice of the peace, to discuss ceremony.
- ◆ Visit bridal registry with fiancée.
- ◆ Start making out your guest list.
- ◆ Discuss honeymoon plans with fiancée; consult travel agent.
- ◆ If traveling abroad, update passports, arrange for visas, international driver's license; check inoculations.

6 MONTHS BEFORE

- ◆ Arrange to pay for bride's bouquet; order boutonnieres, corsages.
- ◆ Complete honeymoon plans; buy tickets.
- ◆ Arrange transportation (limousines) for wedding party to ceremony, reception.
- ◆ Plan rehearsal dinner with parents.

3 MONTHS BEFORE

- ◆ Complete guest list; give to Fiancée.
- ◆ Consult with fiancée on wedding attire for self, men in wedding party.

- ◆ Shop for honeymoon clothes.
- ◆ Order wedding rings.
- ◆ See your doctor for checkup, blood.
- ◆ See your insurance agent to review and combine your insurance needs.

6-8 WEEKS BEFORE

- ◆ Select gifts for bride, ushers.
- ◆ Get legal, religious papers in order.
- ◆ Give or attend bachelor party.
- ◆ Pick up wedding rings.
- ◆ Help fiancée with thank-you notes.

2 WEEKS BEFORE

- ◆ Make a date with your fiancée to get the marriage license.
- ◆ Arrange transportation with best man.
- ◆ Double check honeymoon reservations.

1 WEEK BEFORE

- ◆ Review family seating arrangement with head usher.
- ◆ Put officiate's fee in a sealed envelope and give to best man.
- ◆ Purchase travelers checks.
- ◆ Get your going away clothes ready.
- ◆ Confirm rehearsal dinner, time, wedding day arrival.
- ◆ Pick up wedding attire for self, men in wedding party.
- ◆ Try on in advance.

ON THE WEDDING DAY

- ◆ Don't forget the wedding rings and marriage license.

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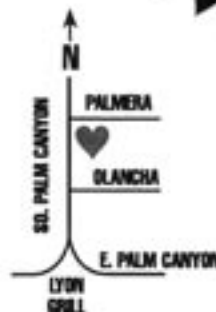


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
